Dear Friends,

Unlike today, dialysis centres were scarce in 1994. Private hospitals were charging exorbitant fees. Government hospitals could barely cope with the limited resources and medical specialists. The National Kidney Foundation (NKF) were assisting patients who were earning less than RM1200.

Many patients, like our first patient, Rusiah Hussien were caught in the 'dialysis dilemma'. They were not rich to afford private treatment, neither were they poor to be in NKF nor too poor to gain access to Government facilities. Rusiah was earning RMI,500. She was struggling with medical bills and long waits for her doctor's appointments. it was the vision of one man; YM Tunku Dato Yaacob Khyra, who invested in one dialysis centre in Kuala Lumpur in 1994, which made it possible for patients like Rusiah to live a healthy life until she passed away in 2017. Today, together, with your support we care for over 800 patients at 12 dialysis centres in 9 states.

With your generosity and kindness, our burden was lighter, our journey was made smoother and we created many milestones and memories (pls ref to pages 6-9). One milestone we are extremely proud of is the establishment of the <u>first</u> and <u>only charitable cardiac and diagnostic treatment centre in Malaysia</u>. Hundreds of patients have been assisted with high subsidies, for cardiac treatments, which they otherwise cannot afford.

Our sincere thanks to all donors, supporters, partners, volunteers, doctors, nurses, suppliers and friends who made it possible for us to serve, especially the underprivileged, the last 25 years (pls refer to pages 4 and 5)

We believe in being transparent and each year we faithfully update our donors on how we spend our funds (pls ref to pages 11-13). You will find our audited accounts on pages 14 and 15.






