Before joining the Maaedicare Charitable Foundation as the Head of Dialysis, Operations, and Training, which runs 11 dialysis centres throughout Malaysia, he established 4 General Practice Clinics in the Klang Valley with a special interest in childcare and paediatrics.

OUR DIALYSIS PATIENTS


68-year-old Lim Teck Poh was a sports enthusiast who played badminton, tennis and squash weekly. But all that came to a standstill when the former senior salesman was diagnosed with kidney failure eight years ago.

Lim, who hails from Batu Pahat, developed hypertension in his late 40s and had to slow down on sports but eventually gave it up when the medication took a toll on his kidneys.

“The last time I picked up a racquet was 20 years ago. Today, I still manage to walk 1,000 steps a day despite being on dialysis,” said Lim, who still finds joy in the little things in life as spending time with his grandchildren and going for walks.

He said it was crucial to keep fit and visits to the doctor regularly must be prioritised.

Lim, whose motto is Que Sera Sera, said he cherishes his dialysis sessions at the Maaedicare Charity Dialysis Centre in Cheras as the clinical staff are hospitable and friendly.



Former secretary K. Muhanthahvathy began insulin therapy at the age of 29. She has had to take four injections daily till today.

A checkup at the Kuala Lumpur Hospital in 2019 compelled her to undergo dialysis treatment on the same day because her creatinine levels were high.

After two sessions at the hospital, her family began to look for a dialysis centre, and found the Maaedicare Charity Dialysis Centre in Cheras.

“I miss travelling the most as when I was healthy and able. I used to travel two times a year,” she reminisced.

Today Muhanthahvathy, 60, feels breathless even when she walks. She uses a wheelchair when out and about and mostly prefers to stay home and rest. Her husband sends her to the dialysis centre for her sessions thrice a week. She remains grateful to him as she would be helpless moving about without his assistance.

“Kidney failure affects everything you do – from diet to lifestyle. One has to be alert and check on one’s health frequently,” she said, adding that it was more crucial when it involves someone with non-communicable diseases such as diabetes or hypertension.

Working in a high-pressure factory environment, Shahrom did not take his health seriously until one day when swollen feet and breathing difficulty demanded a medical test at the hospital.

That is when it dawned on him that his kidneys had failed.

“It was abrupt. I did not know about my condition back then because I had no symptoms,” Shahrom said.

With children to feed and unable to cope with the demanding work burden, it was also a time when his company offered a voluntary separation (VSS) scheme to its employees.

“My situation had a silver lining. I signed up for the VSS and resigned from my job. I then applied for my dialysis. PERKESO sponsored my treatment.

“I have been undergoing treatments diligently,” he said, adding that his diet and lifestyle have also changed due to his medical condition.

He started with the Maaedicare Charity Dialysis centre in Kajang because it was closer to his home in Bukit Mewah. Today, he continues his treatment at our centre in Cheras.

Aside from this, Shahrom said he constantly reminds his six children to take care of their health.

“While being stressed at our jobs becomes unavoidable, we should always find coping mechanisms to ease it and care for our health,” he noted.



KLINIK AMAL PERCUMA (CHARITY FREE CLINIC)

An important milestone in the history of the Foundation - the Klinik Amal Percuma. Began operations in 2022 in Kuala Lumpur and Ipoh.

In partnership with the Malaysian Red Crescent Society (MRCS), the project is expected to alleviate the burden of patient surge in public healthcare facilities, with basic healthcare facilities for the poor.

The MoU between Maaedicare and MRCS was signed in the presence of YTM Dato' Seri DiRaja Tan Sri Tunku Puteri Intan Safinaz binti Almarhum Sultan Abdul Halim Mu'adzam Shah, Tunku Temenggong Kedah, MRCS National Chairperson and YM Tunku Dato' Yaacob Khyra, Chairman of Board of Trustees Maaedicare Charitable Foundation.

It is hoped this joint collaboration will strengthen community healthcare to the masses and empower the transformation of Malaysia's healthcare ecosystem.



MAAEDICARE - NCSM PARTNERSHIP








