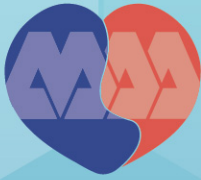

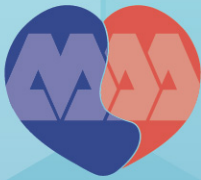
good vibes and enhancing the health and well-being of those who need it most.

Thrilled to announce that our patients from the Maaedicare Charity Dialysis Centre in Jalan Ipoh have been chosen as candidates for kidney transplants through MyKAS (Malaysian Kidney Allocation System) under the Ministry of Health.

7 years ago, before my diagnosis and the start of my treatment, every breath felt like a struggle. Going to the bathroom became a strain, burdened by swollen and heavy legs. Simple acts such as bathing, which I used to do without thinking, was no longer easy. The fatigue was overwhelming, I found myself too tired to work; I felt sick all the time.

I went to the hospital, and the doctor shared serious news that was hard for me to grasp – my kidneys had stopped working.

So, I had to start my treatment right away. With the sessions, it is not easy; you have to be really disciplined. There was no time for fun; every session needed my focus; it is like a big fight against my own body.

But then, in the middle of all these tough dialysis days, there was a bit of good news – I might get a new kidney. I was so happy to be chosen for this special opportunity. Even though I'm just 33, there's a lot of life ahead, and I'm really looking forward to getting better.



I was diagnosed with kidney issues a decade ago when I was working in the tourism industry.

It was a big shock because I had been healthy all the while. Even when I was pregnant with my son, everything seemed okay. Suddenly, I began experiencing monthly episodes of fever. There were no other symptoms, and I went to the hospital. At first, the doctors thought it was dengue. After a full report on blood tests and kidney examinations, they found my kidneys inflamed.

The doctor dug deeper, did a biopsy, and the results were not good. I was diagnosed with Stage 4 lupus nephritis. My creatinine level was over 200, but I didn't go for treatment immediately. I tried other medications, including Chinese medicine. However, after a year, my creatinine shot up to 2,000 and I had to start dialysis.

I was scared at first, worried about what dialysis would be like. Surprisingly, after my first session, I felt much better. But it also meant I had to stop working. I was too tired, and I needed to rest more. It was not a choice; I had to stop working. Even though I consider myself young, I have to limit what I do. I used to love travelling, especially since I was a travel agent.

I've been waiting for a kidney transplant for ten years now. My son is 16 years old; I really want to be around and watch him grow up. I am thankful and extremely happy to be selected as a kidney transplant candidate.

Vomiting became my sole symptom. Regardless of what I ate or drank, I couldn't keep anything down. I felt constantly tired, lacking the energy to work. Eventually, I was admitted to the hospital, where the nurses informed me that there was a 60% chance my kidneys were affected. In just six months, the inevitable dialysis loomed.

At that point, my future looked grim. I hesitated, considering my youth and the fact that my son was still quite young. Thoughts of what would happen haunted me.

Additionally, being a kidney patient took a toll on my income. Finding a job that allowed me to work 5 days/week for 8 hours/day, became a challenge. After my dialysis sessions, I felt too exhausted to work. I would just go home and sleep. The next day, I could manage some work, but eventually, I had to quit my job as a production adviser. As I continued with my treatment, I emotionally committed to a goal: to grant myself ten precious years.

Searching for a kidney donor amongst family members, proved to be a monumental task. Now, having been selected as a candidate for a kidney transplant, I am overjoyed. As a young person, this opportunity has provided me with a glimmer of hope.
